

CLEANING

If your kimono simply needs freshening up, hang it outside away from direct sunlight. We highly recommend that you take your kimono to a professional dry cleaner, who knows that your garment is made up of antique silks and dyes. If you must wash your kimono yourself, please carefully spot clean.

A few things to note:

*If you hand wash your kimono, you are choosing to do so at your own risk.

*SHIBORI fabrics are not designed to be washed as they may lose their unique texture.

*If your kimono contains a dark or red lining, please do not hand wash as the color may bleed and stain the exterior.
